The picture of large components modularized by Moran Iron Works, was being barged downstream on the Detroit River past the Detroit Renaissance Center and was captured by a weather camera. The weather cam only holds pictures in a five minute loop before deleting them and Mr. Hartig had extraordinary timing and fortune to be able to retrieve this image before it was removed.

The tug is towing two barges with each carrying the modularized sections for two identical absorber hood and ductwork systems.
